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ASHRAE San Diego Foundation Scholarship Guidelines

Applicants for scholarships awarded by the ASHRAE San Diego Chapter must meet and adhere to the following:

Criteria

1. Be a potential contributor to the HVAC profession.
2. Attend at least one (1) chapter meeting and at least one (1) student chapter meeting per semester or quarter.
3. Be enrolled in a school with an ABET accredited engineering program at the time the scholarship application is submitted.
4. Satisfy one (1) of the following criteria:
 - a. Be enrolled in a four-year mechanical engineering program.
 - b. Be enrolled in a mechanical engineering or HVAC course and be working in or have experience in an HVAC related field.
5. Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Requisites

1. Complete and submit a scholarship application form.
2. Write an essay of 500 words or more describing intended future career goals and plans.
3. Submit official transcript or record of academic achievement.
4. Be present to accept the scholarship at the chapter's installation and awards banquet in June of the current academic year. In cases where the academic year ends prior to the banquet, the applicant must be present at the previous May chapter meeting to receive the scholarship.

Important Dates

1. Applications must be completed and be received by the ASHRAE San Diego Chapter Student Activities Chair no later than the 5 p.m. on the last day of business in the month of April of the current academic year. The applications that have been received and are complete will then be presented 10 days prior to the Officers and the Board of Governors at the Board of Governor meeting that takes place on the second Tuesday of May in the current academic year.
2. After a 10 day review period, scholarship recipients will be selected at the Chapter's Board of Governor meeting in May of the current academic year with the presentation of the Scholarship(s) taking place at the Chapter's Program event in June of the current academic year.
